PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) and the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority (PRHTA) notify the general public, public and private providers of transportation services, and federal, state and municipal governments the opportunity to review and comment the amendments proposed to the highway component of the following documents:

- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for fiscal years 2014-2017 Amendment #5
- Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for fiscal years 2014-2017 Amendment #5

The aforementioned documents include projects to improve the transportation and highways in Puerto Rico, eligible to be financed with federal funds from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) under Sections 5307, 5309, 5310, 5311, 5337 and 5339. The Metropolitan Planning Organization is considering, by referendum, the proposed amendments to the highway component of the TIPs, for the Urbanized Areas of San Juan, Aguadilla and under 200,000 population. The STIP has to be approved by Federal Agencies.

The documents will be available for review and comments for a period of fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of this notice.
