

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) informs the general public that it proposes to enact a “Regulation to establish all things related with the design, characteristics, use, physical details, display, position, issuance, renovation, cancellation, duplicate of license plates and the amount to be used by different vehicles, as well as the payment”, with the purpose to incorporate the provisions of Act Number 2 of February 1, 2016, which assigns the license plate that identifies the motor vehicle, towing and semi towing vehicles to the registrar owner, which makes the owner responsible for any lien on the vehicle, including the tickets imposed to the vehicle for administrative offenses of movement. It will be enacted according to the Law Number 22 of 2000, as amended, known as *Vehicle and Transit Law of Puerto Rico* and the Law Number 38 of 2017, known as *Uniform Administrative Procedure Law of the Government of Puerto Rico*.

Those interested in reviewing and commenting on the draft of the proposed Regulation may request a copy of the same at the Office of the Legal Counsel, 17th Floor, Roberto Sanchez Vilella Government Center, Stop 22, Santurce, Puerto Rico during working day hours, upon payment of the corresponding fees, or free of cost by accessing our website at: www.dtop.gov.pr You may also request an oral hearing including the reasons that justify the celebration of it.

The DTPW will provide a term of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this Notice to receive written comments from the public and/or the request for an oral hearing.
