The Department of Transportation and Public Works and the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority, hereby notify to the general public, public and private providers of transportation services and federal, state and municipal governments the opportunity to review and provide comments to the proposed changes in the following documents:

•Draft of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the fiscal years 2017-2020, Amendment #2

The TIP includes the programs and projects to improve the transit and highway system to be financed with funds from Federal Transit Administration and Federal Highway Administration. The Puerto Rico Metropolitan Planning Organization is considering, by referendum, the proposed amendment to the transit and highway component of the TIP, for Urbanized Area of San Juan, Aguadilla and Under 200,000 Population.

•Draft of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for fiscal years 2017-2020, Amendment #2

This document includes the programs and projects to improve the Islandwide transit and highway system to be financed with funds from FTA and FHWA. The STIP must be approved by Federal Agencies.
